

**Description**

A special micronized rutile grade, with an hydrophobic organic and medium inorganic surface treatment with aluminium and silicon compounds, with aluminum ion modification in the crystal structure.

**Application**

It possesses good optical properties, opacity, dispersibility, and an excellent degree of resistance to climatic conditions. This grade of titanium dioxide is suitable for demanding plastics manufacturing applications, and for products for interior and exterior use, e.g. injection moulding, rolling, casting, the production of window profiles, plates, hollow objects, polyolefin products, PVC, engineering plastics etc.
